Agenda:

- 1. Review and approve minutes from last meeting Minutes were shared and approved by the SCC members
- 2. Dress code update JSD Board recently approved changes to the dress code policy. These changes provide clarity and utilize current language that is typically generalized in schools and communities. The SCC watched a brief video regarding the changes to the policy. A discussion surrounding hat usage and messaging of safety for all students continued.
- 3. Bully prevention focus and Second Steps A review of the Bully Prevention lesson targets and focus in the classroom.
- 4. Update on Playworks Upcoming activities include a parent day to visit and participate in recess, implementing Junior Coaches to support younger grades in active play, and continued classroom Game Times. Teachers and playground assistants participate in Game Times with students to learn the games and be able to support at recess times.
- 5. Update on Safe Walking Routes and busing to Bluffdale Heights Due to limited use by students at Mountain Point and Hidden Valley, the crossing guard at Porter Rockwell and Freedom Point Way will no

longer be available. Our school currently has three busses that are fairly full. We will submit all requests for bussing permits to Transportation for approval.

- 6. Update on drop off/pick up Typical days pick-up is completed within 8-12 minutes of the ending of the school day.
- 7. Discussion on STEM and Art rotations being combined to STEAM Rationale behind combining Visual Art with STEM lessons primarily due to personnel needs within the school. Supporting Visual Art is a passion of the SCC and there is a desire to find a way to support providing art in the classroom utilizing school volunteers. Ideas will be shared with Team Leaders.
- 8. Halloween A Halloween parade will be planned for outside the school building for community members to join. A backup plan for an indoor parade has been planned in the event of inclement weather. Parade routes and parent information will be shared.
- 9. Other Zoom meetings opportunities as well as a shift to the time meetings are held is desired. Members can make accommodations to work if given enough prior notice if meetings are held at 2:30pm for future meetings.
