CLASSROOMS & DENS	stay in approved areas and keep hands, feet and other objects to myself.	arrive on time, stay on task, cooperate, participate, and work hard to do my best and learn.	follow directions, treat teacher & classmates with respect.
RESTROOMS	walk, report unsafe behavior, report if supplies are needed.	use the restroom quickly and quietly and wash my hands.	clean up after myself and leave the restroom clean for others.
CAFETERIA	walk to line, table, and trash areas, stay in seat until dismissed to recess.	wait patiently in line and talk quietly with friends.	check my area, throw trash away, and leave my area clean.
ROTATIONS	stay in class and participate.	listen and follow directions, do my best work, & clean up after myself.	follow rules, respect staff, and care for school property.
ASSEMBLY CONCERTS	keep my hands, feet and other objects to myself.	sit quietly on my pockets facing toward the speaker.	enter and exit quietly & pay attention to the speaker.
BUS & FIELD TRIPS	stay in my seat and follow the bus driver's rules.	sit quietly, make safe choices, and help others make safe choices.	use kind language & actions.

Rewards for Following Mountain Point Code of Conduct

- My school is a safer, more enjoyable place
- I get a better education and help others do the same;
- I feel confident and safe as I am learning;
- I feel good about myself when I show self-control.

Consequences for Not Following Mountain Point Rules

- Work with teacher first to resolve situation and allow students to resolve issues together when not significant.
- Communicate concerns with parents or guardians.
- Work with administrator to resolve situation.
- Communicate concerns with parents or guardians.
- Most situations can be resolved by working together (students, teachers, parents, and administrators). In the event of significant behavior (disruptive behavior, fighting, persistent inappropriate language or disrespect of students or staff, bullying, etc.) students may be given a lunch detention, in-school suspension, or suspension out of school.

Reporting Process

- Students are advised to notify teacher(s) or administrator(s) with concerns. Mountain Point strives to ensure that all students are

safe while at school. Students are encouraged to fill out a statement to document the concern.

- Parents are encouraged to communicate concerns with teachers or administrators.
- Mountain Point strives to follow district policy regarding bullying and cyber-bullying. Parents and students should report any incidents to the classroom teacher first, then to administration.

Education Process for Students, Parents, Faculty, and Staff

- Students receive instruction on Mountain Point Rules at the beginning of each school year and throughout the year as needed. One student per class is selected monthly for our Student Leadership Award. Emphasizing and recognizing the positive things students are doing in school builds community and encourages students to enjoy school.
- Faculty and staff receive training on Mountain Point Rules at the beginning of each school year.
- Parents receive information about the Mountain Point Rules at www.mountainpoint.jordandistrict.org and at the beginning of each school year during registration.
