Agenda:

1. Review and approve minutes from last meeting – Minutes were shared and approved by the SCC members
2. Safe Walking Routes – There have been no major changes to the walking route. The council discussed the signs that are posted in the parking lot to encourage drivers to follow the traffic flow. Perhaps A-frames with reminders posted about “no stopping” areas and/or “use crosswalks” may help as reinforcers to the expectations. Officer Alvernaz has a schedule of officers parked in the community to help drivers keep to the speed limits. Continue to share information with the community about pick-up and drop-off procedures. Continued request to support with a crossing guard at Coyote Gulch and Noell Nelson intersection.
3. Valentine’s Day – PTA usually has cookies for St. Patrick’s Day. SCC wants Valentine’s boxes to make a come back into classrooms. Have teachers pass out Valentines as it fits for the day of instruction. Encourage volunteers to wear masks if they are passing out treats and food in the classroom. Find a way to share information with families so that volunteers can be available for all classroom parties.
4. DLI Lottery – If we have more than 60 applications for upcoming 1<sup>st</sup>

grade DLI participation, we will need to host a lottery. All members are welcome to join on Monday, February 28<sup>th</sup> for the lottery.

5. Halloween – Proposal to celebrate Halloween on the Friday before Halloween. Next school year Halloween is the first day back from Fall Break. The SCC felt that it is important to celebrate Halloween on the actual day of Halloween. It would be difficult for families to remember costumes and parties if they are held on a different day.

6. Art Rotation – Teachers will be scheduling art volunteers for their class for the months of March, April, and May. Volunteers will need to have the proper paperwork and fingerprinting completed.

7. Recess Protocols – If the outside temperature including windchill is 20 degrees and below, it is considered an inside day. If the air quality is red, it will also be an inside day for students. Communication with teachers should be that recess should still occur during inside recesses to allow for students to socialize. Students should not just be watching a video to pass the time, but be allowed to have some time to talk with other classmates.

8. Other – no other topics were discussed at this time.
